MATERIALS: 4(5;6;7;8;9;) balls of New Kid Seta # 29

One pair US Size 6/ 4mm knitting needles.

MEASUREMENTS:

To fit Bust: 34(36;38;40;42;44) inches

Actual all round measurement of garment: Bust: 36(39;41;43;45;47) inches

Length to shoulder: 21(22;22;22.5;23;23.5) inches

THE INSTRUCTIONS ARE GIVEN FOR THE SMALLEST SIZE, WITH THE LARGER SIZES IN BRACKETS; WHERE ONLY ONE FIGURE IS GIVEN, IT APPLIES TO ALL SIZES.

TENSION: SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME, CHECK TENSION.

22sts and 33 rows = 3 inches / 10m over stocking stitch using US Size 6 / 4mm needles.

FOR BEST RESULTS IT IS ESSENTIAL TO OBTAIN THE CORRECT TENSION.

IF THERE ARE TOO FEW STS ON TEST SWATCH, USE THINNER NEEDLES;

IF THERE ARE TOO MANY STS, USE THICKER NEEDLES.

ABBREVIATIONS:

alt = alternate; **beg** = begin(ning); **cont** = continue; **dec** = decrease; **folll(s)** = follow(s)ing; **inc(s)** = increase(s); **k** = knit; **patt(s)** = pattern(s); **p** = purl; **rep** = repeat; **rev** = reverse; **R(W)S** = right (wrong) side; **R(W)SF** = right(wrong) side facing; **R(W)SR** = right(wrong) side row; **RW** = ribwise; **st (s)** = stitch(es); **st st** = stocking stitch; **tog** = together.

STICHES USED:

DOUBLE RIB PATTERN:

1st row: K2, *p2, k2, rep from * to end.

2nd row: P2, *k2, p2, rep from * to end.

Rep these 2 rows.

STOCKING STITCH:

1st row: K.

2nd row: P.

Rep these 2 rows.

BACK:

Using US Size 6 / 4mm needles cast on 103(109;115;121;127;133) sts and cont straight in st st and when work measures 36cm from beg ending with a WSR,

SHAPE ARMHOLES: Cast off 5(5;5;6;6;6) sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2sts at beg of foll 4(4;4;6;6;6) rows, then dec 1 st (= work 2tog) at each end of every foll alt row 3(5;6;5;6;7) times = 79 (81;85;87;91;95) sts. Cont straight and when work measures 21(22;22.5;23;23;23.5) inches from beg ending with a WSR,

SHAPE SHOULDERS: Cast off 8(8;8;9;9;10) sts at beg of next 4 rows, 7(8;9;8;9;9) sts at beg of foll 2 rows = 33(33;35;35;37;37) sts. Cast off all sts.

RIGHT FRONT:

Using US Size 6/ 4mm needles cast on 103(109;115;121;127;133) sts and cont straight in st st and when work measures 14 inches / 36cm from beg ending with a WSR,

SHAPE ARMHOLE: Cast off 5(5;5;6;6;6) sts at beg of next row, 2sts at beg of foll alt row 2 (2;2;3;3;3) times, then dec 1 st (= work 2tog) at beg of every foll alt row 3(5;6;5;6;7) times = 91 (95;100;104;109;114) sts. Cont straight and when work measures 21(22;22;23;23;23.5) inches from beg ending with a WSR,

SHAPE SHOULDER: Cast off 8(8;8;9;9;10) sts at beg of next and at same edge of foll alt row, then 7(8;9;8;9;9) sts at beg of foll alt row = 68(71;75;78;82;85) sts. Cast off all sts.

LEFT FRONT:

Work as for right front, rev shaping.

SLEEVES (Both Alike):

Using US Size 6 / 4mm needles cast on 59(59;63;65;69;69) sts and cont straight in st st for 2 inches / 5cm ending with a WSR. Cont in st st inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 12 (10;10;8;8;8)th row 8(8;7;4;3;0) times, then every foll 14(12;12;10;10;10)th row 2(4;5;10;11;14) times = 79(83;87;93;97;97) sts. Cont straight and when work measures 17(18;18;18.5;19;19) inches from beg ending with a WSR

SHAPE TOP OF SLEEVE: Cast off 5(5;5;5;6;6) sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2sts at beg of foll 4 (4;4;6;6;6) rows, then dec 1 st at each end of every foll alt row 12(13;14;14;13;13) times. Work 2 rows straight, then dec 1 st at each end of every foll 10(11;12;12;14;14) rows = 17(17;17;19;19;19) sts. Cast off rem sts.

TO MAKE UP:

Sew shoulder seams, leaving fronts hanging open. Set in sleeves. Sew up side and sleeve seams.
